

CHAPTER XI

SCHEME OF STUDIES FOR THE INTERMEDIATE EXAMINATION

1. With effect from 1996, the Punjab Boards will hold the Intermediate Examination Part-wise under the Part System. The Examination for Class XI will be called Intermediate Part-I Examination and the Examination for Class XII will be called Intermediate Part-II Examination.
2. Under the Part System, Paper A will be called Paper I and Paper B will be called Paper II.
3. The candidates will have to take up the Elective Subjects in Part-II in which they had already appeared in Part-I Examination.

The candidates taking up Humanities Group can take three such subjects out of the subjects for the Humanities Group the courses of which are available. Again, at a time two subjects cannot be taken up from the Language Subjects.
