ASSESSMENT REFORMS FOR UP-GRADATION OF EXAMINATION SYSTEM OF BISEs PUNJAB

Dr. Mirza Habib Ali, Chairman, BISE, Lahore presided over a meeting of the Committee constituted by the Controlling Authority of the BISEs in the Punjab regarding assessment reforms and up-gradation of examination system of BISEs of Punjab. Dr. Mazhar Saeed, Chairman, BISE Bahawalpur, Dr. Tayyabah Shaheen, Chairperson, BISE Faisalabad and Dr. Rehana Ilyas, Additional Secretary (Academics), Higher Education Department participated and discussed development of questions item bank, auto generation of question papers, on screen marking, digital attendance and monitoring system, unbundling of scheme of studies, Relative Grading System (RGS), exchange program for paper setting and paper marking and various management reforms. After detailed discussion and deliberation, it was recommended that a dedicated "Evaluation and Assessment Wing" should be established in BISEs Punjab to develop 'Question Item Bank' (QIB). It was also decided to develop the first QIB for Biology and auto generation of its question papers for SSC, 2nd Annual Examination, 2023.



The Committee recommended that BISEs in Punjab shall adopt 'On Screen Marking' phase wise. The Committee also recommended that from session 2022 and onwards each BISE would conduct Two Annual Examinations and the candidates will have the choice for participation in any of the examinations (like "O/A Level Exams") as "Full" or "in Parts" after depositing the prescribed fee.



The Committee also recommended achieving ISO Certification in BISEs Punjab within a period of one year and to launch GIS based mapping of affiliated institutions and examination centers within 6 months.

ACTUARIAL ASSESSMENT OF BISEs, IN PUNJAB FOR FINANCIAL STABILITY



Dr. Mirza Habib Ali, Chairman, BISE, Lahore / Convener of Sub Committee constituted by the Punjab Boards Committee of Chairmen (PBCC) for the actuarial assessment of the funds in BISEs of the Punjab. In this connection, the Convener visited the office of Dr. Sohail Chand, Principal of Statistics Department, University of the Punjab, Lahore and discussed the matter regarding increasing gap between revenue and expenditures of BISEs in the Punjab. After thorough deliberations, it was decided to adopt the process of actuarial assessment of the funds, especially pension funds in order to avoid any future crisis.

4000+ AGENTS OF HBL WILL PROVIDE THE FACILITY TO DEPOSIT DUES



An agreement was signed between BISE Lahore and HBL in January 2022 for a digital banking facility for students and other stakeholders of BISE Lahore. The ceremony was duly attended by Chairman BISE, Dr. Mirza Habib Ali and HBL Senior Regional Chief, Mahmood Sharif Janjua along with Myra Malik, Senior Area Manager Habib Bank Limited. This facility will also provide an interface to BISE Lahore



for transparent and quick reconciliation of its Accounts. More than 4000 agents of HBL will provide the facility to deposit dues of BISE Lahore by the students at their doorstep.

Dues can also be deposited at any other bank, jazz cash and easy paisa account etc. QR code generated by BISE Lahore will also be accepted by the digital system of HBL. The Finance Department, IT teams of BISE Lahore and HBL are working together for the implementation of this initiative. Hopefully, this facility will be available from the first week of April 2022.

POLICE RECRUITMENT EXAMINATION

South (Bahawalpur, D.G Khan and Multan), North (Faisalabad, Gujranwala and Rawalpindi) and Central Zone (Lahore, Sahiwal and Sargodha). However, Test Centers were established only at three locations, viz., Lahore, Gujranwala & Bahawalpur and 84,000 candidates appeared for the test in all zones.

Dr. Mirza Habib Ali, Chairman, BISE Lahore executed the entire activity in collaboration with the Chairmen BISE, Gujranwala and Bahawalpur. In the Central Zone, i.e. Lahore, Sahiwal and Sargodha, 158 examination centers for 31,500 candidates were set-up.

According to the Provincial Cabinet decision, the test was conducted in three zones, that is,

171st MEETING OF INTER-BOARDS COMMITTEE OF CHAIRPERSONS (IBCC)

The 171st meeting of IBCC was convened on 17-18 March, 2022 (Thursday-Friday), at Nathia Gali under the Chairpersonship of Sargodha Board. Chairpersons of all Educational Boards across the country participated in this meeting. Mst. Kausar Raees, Chairperson, BISE, Sargodha headed this meeting and various matters were discussed. Dr. Mirza Habib Ali, Chairman, BISE Lahore informed the House in detail about the regulation/rules regarding minimum age limit for registration in Class-IX and SSC Examination. The House appreciated the Chairman for highlighting this issue. Accordingly, this main issue and other important issues regarding the minimum age limit for registration in Class-IX and passing the SSC Examinations were also discussed. The House unanimously decided the minimum age limit from 14 years to 12 years across the country on the analogy of BISEs in Punjab.

The House also approved the appointment of Prof. Saeed-ud-Din (Chairman Inter-Board, Karachi), as Chairman Sports Committee. It was also decided that the Board would provide writers to blind candidates during the examinations rather than allowing such candidates to manage their own writers. Besides this, a Committee was formulated to submit its report in the next meeting regarding allowing the engineering students to take examinations of medical subjects. The House also decided to bar all the universities except the Allama Iqbal Open University and Karakoram University from conducting matriculation, intermediate and diploma examinations. Dr. Mirza Habib Ali, Chairman, BISE Lahore presented a photograph to Mst. Kausar Raees, Chairperson, BISE Sargodha.



TRAINING / WORKSHOP

Training for Paper Setters

An extensive training / workshop of 60 Paper Setter of equal weightage subjects was conducted for the SSC Examination, 2022 from 3rd to 8th January, 2022. The Primary purpose of the training / workshop was to put emphasis on setting of question papers according to the cognitive levels as envisaged in Bloom's Taxonomy so that the students may develop their skills to solve questions of higher order thinking. All participants took active part in the training / workshop.



Later on, 90 paper setters of non-equal weightage subjects attended the 2nd phase of training from 15th to 25th January, 2022. During the 3rd phase, a 12-days workshop was organized for 90 paper setters of equal weightage subjects of HSSC examinations from 27th January to 7th February, 2022. Last but not the least, a 6-days training workshop was conducted for 50 paper setters of non-equal weightage subjects of HSSC examinations from 28th March to 2nd April, 2022.
